ESTONIA MINUTES 19TH – 23RD NOVEMBER 2018



AR.AC.N.E. project starts on the 19th of November in Estonia, in the wonderful framework of the medieval city of Tallinn, in the warmness of Tallinn people welcome, surrounded by the happiness as well as great professionalism of the Tallinna Kesklinna Vene Gümnaasium' teachers and students! The agenda of the five



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days was exciting, full of great moments when students, guided by teachers, immersed in the theme of ART!

Main Outputs

- Promote ART and the Social and Educational value of European Cultural Heritage among students

- Develop language skills, multiligualism, the promotion of intercultural dialogue and the consolidation of European identity

- Allow peer education
- implement innovative teaching methods and they include formal and informal activities.

As the first mobility in AR.AC.N.E. project, in the five days of activities, all participating countries met in several meetings to discuss the main objective of Aracne project: in the year when European Year of Cultural Heritage is celebrated and European Union aims to help rekindle a sense of belonging to a common European family and highlights that cultural heritage is a resource for Europe, AR.AC.N.E involve students and teachers of the Partnership in a transnational, educational experience where ART, with its precious, national peculiarity, is the core-theme.

So, all participating schools presented in Estonia with a work of art and students were protagonist of the artistic workshops in agenda, took part in creative activities, visited art galleries and museums.

In particular Estonia Mobility was dedicated to ANNIVERSARY OF ESTONIA: preserving culture in a digitally developed society. As a consequence, digital art was the focus of the five days of activities. Students practised the limitless opportunities of virtual world, using their creativity and generating new ideas.

Estonia started the way to reach the main expected outputs of ARACNE:

Workshops, where each country presented the products expressly made for the project to the partner schools.

Permanent art gallery: to collect the project's objects or works of art, but also the ones realised before by the school. With reference to the permanent art gallery, Italian school presents the opportunity to set up an ARACNE permanent art gallery for the final mobility in Gallipoli (Italy) and all partners agree with this idea.

The permanent art galleries will be a place of art, maintained also after the project end and the works of art will continue to be exhibit in itinerant art galleries, every time the schools find it useful to spread intercultural value of Art.

Also teachers in their school year programming phase will be oriented to use ARACNE materials for

their didactics

The first meeting also set up the agreement to create the main communication means, finalised to share the incredible wonderful experience of ARACNE project:

- 3) School websites: the project display will be maintained on the single schools websites


During Estonia mobility, Estonia school, in response to its digital vocation, created:


- 4) A facebook page <u>https://www.facebook.com/groups/1947090642253739/?ref=group_header</u>

Moreover, Czeck Republic School would contribute by creating the twin space and all partners would cooperate in the GANTT of actions (project activities calendar) and the Evaluation Plan, the latter due to Italy, as coordinator, but enriched by inputs and contribution from all Schools.

A great moment in Estonia Mobility was the election of the Project "Logo". Each Partner Country arrived with its own proposal

and a votation among all partners (teachers and students) declared Italian logo the winner





Another key point of the first ARACNE mobility in Estonia was sharing up the PLANNED MOBILITIES CALENDAR :

November 2018 - to ESTONIA - students + teachers March 2019 - to CZECH REP.- students + teachers May 2019 - to TURKEY – only staff February 2020 - to ROMANIA- students + teachers May 2020 - to ITALY – students + teachers
